
#### ST GREGORY'S WELD BANK 1774 - 2024

# **REFLECTION**In today's gospel, we hear that Jesus took his disciples up a

mountain away from the business of the marketplace. This was not unusual in itself as we know from the gospels that Jesus himself often went up the mountain to pray on his own, but while they were on the mountain, something very unusual happened - Jesus was transformed beyond all recognition. His face shone like the sun and his clothes became as white as the light. Imagine the surprise and shock of those who were with Jesus at this time. As Jesus continued his journey towards Jerusalem, he knew what he was facing - he would be betrayed, denied, condemned and crucified. Perhaps he felt and sensed the disciples fear and anxiety and wanted to reassure them. By revealing himself to them in all his glory, he gave them a glimpse of things to come. Like the disciples, we too are often at a loss and wonder what is happening to us - so where is God in the midst of our confusion and darkness? Pope Francis said, 'Loving actions change history: even the ones that are small, hidden, every day. For God guides history through the humble courage of those who pray, love and forgive. There are so many hidden saints, who are next-door, who with little acts of love, change history'. We can see examples of this every day in the work of our fire fighters, police, paramedics & other hospital staff, carers, those who work in the foodbanks....the list is endless and some are more visible than others. Maybe that brief glimpse of Jesus in all his glory seen by his disciples is also meant for us today. Perhaps like the disciples, we too need to be encouraged and strengthened by Jesus. As we continue our journey through Lent, we too need know that our prayer, fasting and sharing with the poor is not an end in itself or that it is all done in vain. The experience of Jesus

that it is all done in vain. The experience of Jesus transformed offers each of us a taste of what lies ahead of us. This is the hope in which we are asked to have faith as we make our way through Lent. When we are tempted to give up or give in, let us look to Jesus transformed and let us do

what the voice of God says to each of us; 'This is my Son, The Beloved, Listen to him.'
