# REFLECTION

Today we celebrate the feast of Corpus Christi – The Body and Blood of Jesus. As the gospel today tells us, 'the bread that I shall give is my flesh for the life of the world'. The Body and

Blood that Jesus offers to each of us calls and binds us together as disciples of Jesus and feeds, nurtures and nourishes us. For many people daily mass is a time not only to pray but to meet others in the parish community. When we come to mass it is both a spiritual and social experience. Through celebrating the Eucharist we are connected to each other and to Jesus in a most sacred and unique way. The church reminds us that the Eucharist is the source and summit of Christian life. For each of us, it is the source of our daily lives as we draw life and energy from the Body and Blood of Jesus. Celebrating the Eucharist with others calls and helps us to live our daily lives as followers of Jesus. When Jesus ate his last meal with his friends he gave them and us the gift of his Body and Blood. He said that whenever we share in this sacred meal we are to do it in memory of him. He also washed their feet as a sign of service and said that this was the example that they and we are to follow if we want to be his followers. When we care for and serve each other we are also asked to do it in memory of Jesus. The concluding prayer of the mass asks us to go now to love and serve the Lord. We do this by loving and serving each other as best we can in our daily lives. Because we have shared in the Body and Blood of Christ we are called to love and serve each other as Jesus loves and serves us. Having been in communion with

Jesus, we are called to care for each other and be in communion with those around us in our families and our community. Celebrating and sharing in the Eucharist and serving each other are two sides of the same coin; we can't have one without the other. St. Augustine says that when we share in the Eucharist, 'believe what you see and become what you are, the Body of Christ. When we say 'amen' we are saying, 'yes' I believe that this is Body of Jesus and I will become the Body of Christ for others.' Today and always, may the Body and Blood of Jesus strengthen, encourage and sustain each of us.
