

REFLECTION

In today's Gospel, Jesus shares his mission to proclaim the kingdom of heaven with his disciples. They are to do the work that Jesus has already been doing: the sick are cured, lepers are cleansed, demons are driven out, and the dead are raised to life. The disciples are sent to continue doing the work that Jesus has begun.

But before he does this we are told he saw the crowd and felt sorry for them, and he sees in his disciples as co-worker and beloved friends. Knowing we are beloved comes first—before any ministry, or service. If we don't start with knowing our beloved and co-workers, We can be torn. Rather than ministry being a freely given gift, our efforts can be driven by a need to prove ourselves, to win praise and admiration.

Part of ongoing conversion as disciples of Jesus, sent out as laborers for the harvest, is growing in freedom.

Freedom to say "yes" to an invitation to service when we can and we have the time.

Freedom to serve joyfully—whether those we serve respond with gratitude or indifference, Freedom to know we are precious just as we are

Freedom that comes from knowing we are beloved first and foremost, and all our actions overflow from that truth.

As Jesus sent his disciples to continue his work and mission, so too the Church is sent by Jesus. The Church is his continuing presence on earth. All the members of the church are his beloved and call to share his mission.
