REFLECTION



Today, as we continue the sacred season of Christmas, we celebrate this important day in the company and presence of our Lady, the Mother of God. Mary is not only central to Advent and Christmas, she is also central to God's plan for salvation. From the moment of her conception, through her being called personally by God to be the Mother of Jesus and her final vigil at the foot of the cross, Mary is offered to us as the prime example of what it is to be a follower of Jesus as his disciple. In reality, the gospels don't actually give us a lot of details about Mary's life, all we have are fragments of the important things that happened to her. The gospel for today's wonderful feast is one of those gospels. On Christmas Day the gospel told us that shepherds made their way to the manger to see the new born child and his parents. The gospel today tells us that they hurried away from the manger sharing with everyone everything they had seen and experienced. It must have been an occasion that was full of excitement and

have been an occasion that was full of excitement and perhaps even some confusion. But somehow, with all that what was going on around her, Mary treasured all these things in her heart. Wisely, she did not dismiss, deny or ignore anything that happened to her - instead, she accepted all that was taking place was part of God's plan for her and for the whole human race. Through grace and the gift of faith, Mary co-operated fully with what God asked of her; not just at her

Annunciation, but each and every day of her life as she followed Jesus. This is Mary's greatness and her example that we are asked to follow in our own daily lives. Difficult though it can be sometimes to believe or accept, God does have a plan for each of us; no matter what happens to us.

So today, let us ask ourselves - can we too follow the example of Mary and put our faith, hope and trust in God?

POPE FRANCIS RENEWS CALLS FOR PEACE IN THE UKRAINE

Earlier this week, on the feast of the martyr St Stephen, Pope Francis called on all Catholics to pray for those who have harmed them — and those persecuted — as he renewed his call for peace in the Ukraine and worldwide. He said: 'Let us ask the newborn Jesus for the newness of a heart capable of forgiveness: we all need a forgiving heart!

Let us ask the Lord for this grace: Lord, may I learn to forgive.

Let us ask for the strength to pray for those who have hurt us, to pray for those who have harmed us, and to take steps of openness and reconciliation'.

Pope Francis concluded with a prayer to 'Our Lady, Queen of martyrs' to 'help us to grow in charity, in love of the Word and in forgiveness'.

On this feast of Mary, the Mother of God, let us pray:

Mary, most holy Virgin and Queen of Martyrs, accept the sincere homage of my devoted affection. Into your heart, pierced by so many swords, do you welcome my poor soul. Receive it as the companion of your sorrows at the foot of the Cross, on which Jesus died for the redemption of the world. With you, O sorrowful Virgin, I will gladly suffer all the trials, contradictions, and infirmities which it shall please our Lord to send me. I offer them all to you in memory of your sorrows, so that every thought of my mind, and every beat of my heart may be an act of compassion and of love for you. And you, sweet Mother, have pity on me, reconcile me to your divine Son Jesus, keep me in His grace, and assist me in my last agony, so that I may be able to meet you in heaven and sing your glories. Amen.
