REFLECTION

Today's readings are centered on the Word of God. The Gospel reading is from the 4th of the 28 chapters of St Matthew's account, the first two chapters, focussing on the advent and infancy of Jesus. Today's Gospel account begins the public life of Jesus in the cities and villages of Galilee. His `mission does not begin in the religious, social and political centre of Jerusalem, but in an area on the outskirts looked down upon by the most observant Jews because in that region, various foreign peoples of different races, cultures, and religions converged. In this way, Galilee became a symbolic place for the Gospel to become open to all nations. After Jesus called two sets of brothers to become 'fishers of men', he performed three works of public ministry - teaching, preaching, and curing the sick. When choosing his first disciples and future apostles, he did not turn to the schools of scribes and doctors of the Law, but to simple, humble people to diligently prepare for the coming of the Kingdom of God. Jesus chose to call them where they worked on the lakeshore as fishermen - he called them by name and they left their nets

and followed him immediately. The fact that the short form of today's Gospel reading ends by focusing upon Jesus' preaching suggests how central preaching was to his public ministry. In fact, the only words that we hear Jesus preaching

in today's Gospel reading are: 'Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is close at hand'. Repentance is the first word of Jesus' preaching the Word of God and for those who hear the Word of God, repentance is the first word of following Jesus. Our world of today with its many different cultures, is a bit like Galilee. We live in a world where we too are immersed in a kind of 'Galilee of the nations', a world which at times may make us feel threatened or afraid - a world in which we may try to build fences to make us feel safer and more protected. But Jesus teaches us that the Good News, which he brings, is not reserved for just one part of the human race but is to be communicated to everyone regardless of race, culture or creed - and that is our mission. Today, God is calling each of us to work with him in the 'Galilee' of our times. He is calling

each of us by name - Come Follow Me!
