REFLECTION

These days, many people suffer from anxiety. We are all facing a world with many problems and difficulties. For anyone seeking an antidote to restlessness and fear, today's readings have something to say about peace and God's presence in our lives and world that is worth exploring. Jeremiah, the prophet speaks of his persecutors insulting him, trying to incite fear and failure. How many people, young people especially, suffer from this sort of behavior from others on line through social media or even in person? Noteworthy in the Jeremiah reading is that despite his enemies' bullying and fear mongering, Jeremiah is assured: "The Lord is with me." God is a peaceful, energetic response to his and

so to our anxiety. Though anxious thoughts can seem allconsuming, we are not alone in moments of darkness, peace is near. In today's Gospel, Jesus tells the disciples, and therefore us, that he speaks in darkness. When we feel in a dark place, Jesus is saying to us, you are still loved, and still alive. This is God's voice, a gift that brings peace. This peace reminds us that we are never truly alone. Even though the existence of the stars, galaxies and the whole Universe illustrates to us just how small we are in comparison. Even so we are re-assured that we are known and loved: "Even the hairs of your head are counted.

So do not be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows," Jesus tells us. May we accept this reality, not only for ourselves, but also for those around us who might need a reminder that God is near and all people are precious in his sight, that can see even in the darkest place.
