REFLECTION

In the gospel today Jesus takes Peter, James and his brother John away from the business of the village and market place and invites them to travel with him as he makes his way up the mountain. We know from the gospels that it was not unusual for Jesus to go off by himself up into the mountains

to pray. Whilst they were there praying, Jesus was transfigured; he changed; his face shone like the sun, and his clothes became as white as the light. Imagine how surprised and shocked they all must have been. Then Peter uttered these words, 'Lord, it is wonderful for us to be here'. But more

importantly than that, a voice from the cloud said to them, 'This is my Son, the Beloved, he enjoys my favour. Listen

to him'. These words are also relevant for us today. The message that Jesus offers us is life-changing if we choose to open our hearts and hear it. The Transfiguration gives us a fleeting glimpse of Jesus in all his glory. It is a taste of what is to come and is offered in order to encourage and challenge us in our daily lives. Sometimes, we can get locked into our own world and our particular situation and we can forget about or lose sight of the fact that we are part of a much bigger world. It reminds us therefore that our lives are far more than what we see, hear and experience every day. Being a follower of Jesus is about living with meaning, purpose and hope. The transfiguration not only offers us a glimpse of Jesus in all his

glory, it also offers each of us a foretaste of what God promises to us in the fullness of his Kingdom. We will never experience anything as powerful as The Transfiguration in our own lifetimes, but every day in countless and seemingly small ways God does break into our lives. Every time we experience a moment of peace, joy, reconciliation or forgiveness, God is with us. Every time that we reach out to help another person is a moment of transfiguration both for ourselves and for those we help and each time somebody shows care and concern for us is a moment when God reaches out to us. This week, let us open our hearts so that we may hear Jesus speaking to us and let us take time to slow down and look for moments of small but important times of transfiguration in our own ordinary daily lives.
