REFLECTION

There is a double-edged message in today's readings. On the one hand, we are told that the blessings of God's kingdom are for all peoples, not just a select few but on the other hand, we are warned not take for-granted that we are 'on the A list' and have a pre-booked place at the royal banquet. Rather, we should try our best to enter 'by the narrow gate' that is, to keep our minds and heart focused on Jesus and follow his example. Jesus invites us to be his friend and follow him but at times this is not an easy path. Following Jesus' example asks a lot of us. Although we are all created in the image and likeness of God, we can only dream of success, fame and pleasure and spend much of our time and effort trying to make at least some of these dreams come true. The reality is that we will always encounter along the way people or circumstances that will shatter those dreams. Our dreams will or will not be realised based on the decisions that we make every day which determine the course of our lives. Today, we witness a very important 'moment of decision' faced by Jesus' disciples. Will they continue to follow him in a way that will bind them into a covenanted community diverse, yet one people? Or will they follow a different path, return to their former life and walk away? We are told that many of Jesus' disciples found his teaching too hard to take. Some couldn't accept his words and many others simply chose the other path and returned to their former way of life. The path that we are called to follow as disciples of Jesus is

The path that we are called to follow as disciples of Jesus is equally challenging, but it is also equally rewarding – the path of eternal salvation. In today's Gospel, the path of eternal salvation is described by Jesus as people coming from the east and west, from the north and the south to take their place at the feast in the Kingdom of God. The first letter of the four directions of the compass, that is, north, east, west and south spells the word, NEWS. The Good News for us as followers of Jesus is that in Christ, all the nations, from every direction, are to be saved, meaning no one is excluded from

the possibility of sharing God's life forever.

The question is, are we ready to accept the challenge?

REVISED & REVERSED COVID REQUIREMENTS

With the increase of infection rates and the new variants, the guidelines from the Archdiocese have changed and the following now apply:

- 1. Face-coverings are highly recommended for people who attend Sunday Masses.
- 2. **Sanitiser** please sanitise your hands before entering the church.
- 3. **Ventilation** the doors to the church will remain open throughout each service during the summer months.
- 3. **Social Distancing** there will **no** designated section of the church with social distancing.
- 3. **Holy Communion** ministers will be required to wear a face covering whilst distributing Holy Communion and will cleanse their hands before & after distributing Holy Communion.
- 4. Holy Communion under both kinds will not be reintroduced at this time.

NB: We have been informed of a number of parishioners suffering from Covid recently so please be cautious and do not attend if you have any symptoms.

MASS CARDS

We have a selection of Mass cards/Sympathy/Baptism/First Holy Communion and other greeting cards which can be purchased from the Parish Office.

GRAVEYARD REGULATIONS

It is becoming increasingly difficult to facilitate the safety, maintenance and appearance of our graveyards due to the number of crosses, pots and memorabilia that are appearing on and around graves. Please note that there are strict regulations which must be followed in order to keep all our graveyards safe and well maintained. Pots and memorabilia can be placed at the foot of the headstone and on the footing but should not encroach onto the grassed area or onto adjacent graves or pathways. The addition of crosses and plaques is strictly by permission of the parish priest only and may only be considered temporary pending the erection of a permanent memorial. Any crosses and plaques that are erected or placed on graves without permission will be removed. Notices warning of this will be posted in the graveyards for the next 28 days after which the items will be removed and stored by the sexton pending collection by the owners. Thank you.
