

PENTECOST AND THE EUCHARIST

Just as a lover delights in showering gifts upon the beloved, so too does God. He comes to 'make his home with us', he heals and makes us whole by giving himself to us in the Eucharist. He blesses us with the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on this feast of Pentecost.

We can't earn the Holy Spirit, we can't deserve the Holy Spirit, we can't own the Holy Spirit. The Spirit is the gift of the Father. And the Spirit draws us to Eucharistic Adoration, urging and encouraging us to

It is necessary to invite the third Divine Person to be:

Rest in labour, Relief in oppressive heat,

Consolation in weeping.

We can't do without the Spirit's work:

"Heal what is wounded."

It's easy to understand why the Orthodox Ecumenical Patriarch Athenagoras often repeated that 'without the Spirit, God is far away, Christ remains in the past, the Gospel is a dead letter, the Church is a simple organisation, authority a domination, mission propaganda, worship mere evocation, and Christian action a slave morality. But in the Spirit... the Risen Christ is present, the Gospel is the power of life, the church signifies Trinitarian communion, authority is a liberating service, mission is a Pentecost, the liturgy is memorial and

anticipation, human activity is deified.' Come, Holy Spirit!
